

Ag & Art Adventure Directions – SUNDAY ONLY

Start - Permaculture Garden/Church of the Good Shepherd (from Matthews)

Directions from Hwy 58:

*Coming from Independence (the West), follow Hwy 58 East for 9.3 miles, you will see the Church of the Good Shepherd on your left....turn left at the next turn off, do a U-turn onto Hwy 58 East, the Church will be on your right

*Coming from Galax (the East), the Church of the Good Shepherd will be on your right, turn right at the sign and you will see the Permaculture Garden

To Independence/1908 Courthouse/Frosty Monkey/Ciro's

Turn right onto Hwy 58 West and follow for 9.3 miles into Independence

The 1908 Courthouse will be on your right, you can park anywhere on the street or lower lot of the Grayson County Courthouse and walk over

Laura Bryant will be in 1908

Frosty Monkey/Ciro's/Jordan's Garden are within walking distance of 1908; Frosty Monkey and Ciro's are sponsored Food Stops

To Rolling Acres Farm from Independence

Turn right onto Hwy 21 N/Independence Ave and follow for 0.4 miles

Turn left onto Elliott Place and follow for 1.2 miles

Farm will be on your right at White Picket Fence (#1310)

To The Station at Elk Creek from Rolling Acres Farm

Turn left onto Elliott Place out of farm and follow 1.2 miles back to Hwy 21 N/Independence Ave.

Turn left onto Hwy 21 N/Independence Ave. and follow 8.8 miles

The Station at Elk Creek will be on left (white building past Marathon gas station)

To Summerfield Farm – Carsonville location from The Station (SUNDAY ONLY)

Turn right out of The Station on Hwy 21 South and follow for 0.3 miles

Turn left onto Carsonville Rd. and follow for 2 miles

Farm will be on your right at #2102 (new board fence entrance)

To Osborne Farm & Nursery from Summerfield Farm – Carsonville location (SUNDAY ONLY)

Turn left out of farm onto Carsonville Rd. and follow for 2 miles

Turn left onto Hwy 21 S/Independence Ave. and follow for 8.5 miles into Independence

Turn right onto Hwy 58 West and follow for 2 miles

Osborne Farm/Nursery will be on your left

To New River Highlands from Osborne Farm/Nursery

Turn left out of farm onto Hwy 58 West and follow for 0.3 miles

New River Highland will be on your left at Rixey's Market

To River Ridge Organics/Berry Patch from NR Highlands

Turn left out of Rixey's parking lot onto Battlefield Dr. (Warehouse side) and follow 3.5 miles

Turn left onto Cox's Chapel Rd. and follow for 0.2 miles, you will cross over the one lane bridge over the New River

After you cross bridge, the Berry Patch will be on your left almost immediately about 0.1 mile

To Wells Farm from River Ridge organics

Turn right out of Berry Patch onto Cox's Chapel Rd. and follow for 0.2 miles crossing back over one lane bridge over the New River

At stop sign, turn right onto Bridle Creek Rd. and follow for 0.2 miles

Turn left to stay on Bridle Creek Rd. and follow for 1.6 miles

At stop sign turn left onto Hwy 58 West and follow for 11 miles
Turn left onto Orchard Lane just past Corner Market
Go straight towards Gray House

Corner Market & Café is a sponsored Food Stop

To Rugby Creek Animal Rescue from Wells Farm/Corner Market

Turn right out of farm onto Hwy 58, then make next right to stay on Hwy 58 West/Grayson Highlands Pkwy at Corner Market and continue following Hwy 58 for 4 miles
Turn left onto Rugby Rd. and follow 1.2 miles
Turn right into main farm entrance/at green Rugby Creek Entrance #2

***Grayson Highlands Store – sponsored Food Stop (from Rugby Creek Animal Rescue)*

Turn left out of farm onto Rugby Rd. and follow 1.2 miles

Turn left onto Hwy 58, Grayson Highlands Store will immediately be on your left

To Creeper Trail Campground from Rugby Creek Rescue

Turn left out of farm onto Rugby Rd. and follow 1.2 miles

Turn left onto Hwy 58 and follow for 11.6 miles

Grayson Highlands Store – Sponsored Food stop will immediately be on your left after turning onto Hwy 58

Turn left onto Old Park Rd. between Railroad Café and Creeper Trail Bike Rentals and follow for 2 miles

Cross Creeper Trail and turn left at Creeper Trail Campground sign/Route 726 and follow for 0.5 miles

Turn right into Creeper Trail Campground at sign
